In the Home Base and Center Base Programs families learn about:

In the home base program, a Family Infant Toddler Educator meets with you at home once a week and every other week you and your child attend socialization at the center.

In this program you receive one on one support, year round at NO COST to you!

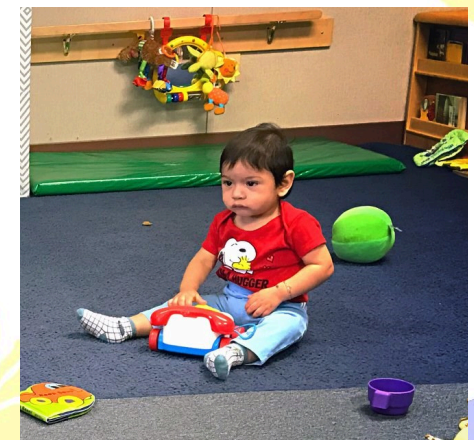


FREE Center base program services!
